On the other hand, dealing with 13 children of different family backgrounds and with different attitudes every day is such a huge responsibility to handle but God has His own way to make it possible as one of our very own MPFG product, Elene Joyce Espino was employed last June 2017 to

Ramos how she has improved from being shy to being active and is now interacting with others, enjoys school, and improved a lot in her studies as the rest of them. We know that each child has a unique ability that needs to be nurtured in the way that motivates them to become responsible in the future. These children are trained to be responsible of their own selves and things, (wash and clean), study well in school, do some gardening, cooking, singing, and dancing but above all is



to train them to love God and His word. It's not an instant process to see the progress but it takes time and effort to see the fruit of our labor together. We cannot determine how long we

can keep these children but only through what God has directed us we will by His grace alone. Having no sustainable resources to keep this project going is a great testing of faith for us. It indeed requires an extra miles since we are only dependent on the donations we have received but we know our God is a faithful God and knows no limit. He knows the intent of our hearts and passion and even knows our own limitations. We truly appreciate those who have given

programs (widows and elderly) who are in need of extra care but this depends on


